History

Origin of the name

Modern historians believe that the name Khachmaz derives from khachmataki tribe of Huns, which transformed into Khacmaz in the middle of 7th century. It is also interesting, that part of the tribe in the second middle of the 7th century migrated to the territory of the current Oghuz district having constructed the settlement and naming Khachmar fortress.

Tourism

Khachmaz is considered a popular tourist destination, especially due to the Nabran district. The combination of a very good summer climate, woods along the seashore and excellent golden beaches was exploited by the construction of large numbers of hotels and apartments in Nabran.

The Event Center is the “Ulduz” Holiday Center in Yalama village.

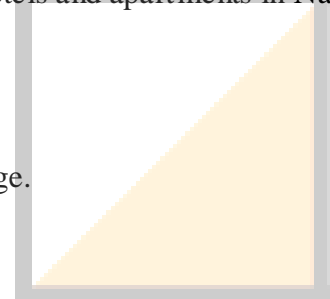
Working Hours for the Event Center will be:

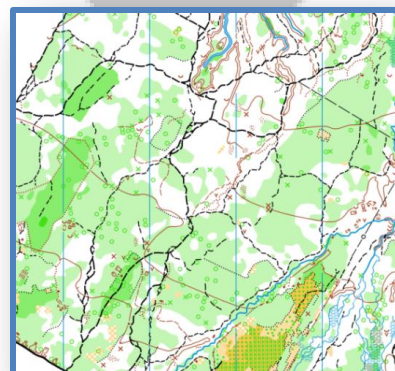

5. TERRAIN & COURSES

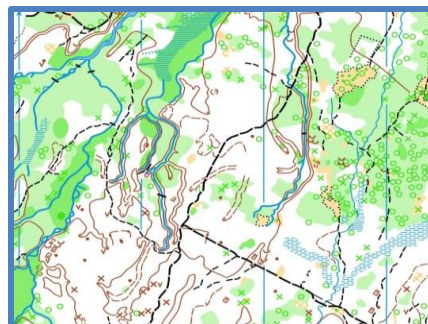
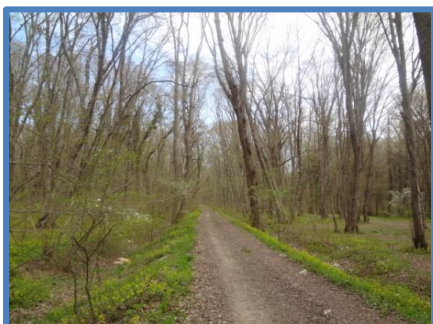
HeydarAliyev Cup, Long Distance – Salimoba – Khazar tourist base

The terrain is with streams, with a lot of glades with varying visibility. In some places the terrain is difficult.



HeydarAliyev Cup, Middle Distance – Salimoba

Larch forest with adverse terrain. Highly developed the system of forest roads and trails.



6. COURSE DETAILS

HeydarAliyev Cup, Long Distance

(31 May 2014)

Format: Long Distance, individual start interval of 2'.

Map: Salimoba, 1:10000, 2.5 contour interval; Khazar Tourist Base, 1:10000, 2.5 contour interval.

Terrain: in some places low visibility, a lot of streams.

Distance from Event Center: 15 km

Preliminary Course Details:

Men (M-21): 10-11 km, 18-24 controls;

Women (W-21): 6.5-7.5 km, 14-18 controls;

Men (Open): 4.5 km, 8-10 controls;

Women (Open): 3.5 km, 8-10 controls

Junior (children): 1.5-2 km, 6 controls.



The control time for all competitors is 3.5 hours.

HeydarAliyev Cup, Middle Distance

(1 June 2014)

Format: Middle Distance, individual start interval of 2'.

Map: Salimoba, 1:10 000, 2.5 contour interval;

Terrain: in some places low visibility, a lot of streams.

Distance from Event Center: 15 km

Preliminary Course Details:

Men (M-21): 6.5 km, 15 controls;

Women (W-21): 4.5 km, 12 controls;

Men (Open): 2.5 km, 8 controls;

Women (Open): 2 km, 6-8 controls;

Junior (children); 1 km, 3-4 controls.

The control time for all competitors is 2 hours.

7. PUNCHING SYSTEM

The SportIdent punching system will be used for the HeydarAliyev Cup.

8. FINAL ENTRIES

Final entry deadline: 23 May 2014.

Final entries include the following information:

All competitors and team leaders: family name, first name, nation, gender and type of the distance, year of birth, passport number;

The Final Entry Form to be used will be available on the Federation website as of 7 April 2014.

We have no entry fees.

Identity badges, new competition maps, start and results lists are free.

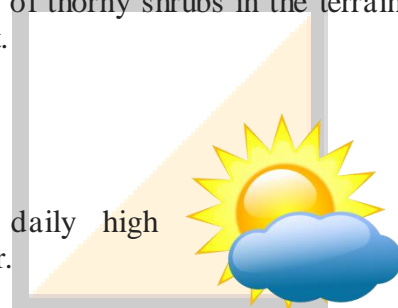
